## **General Terms**

**Position:** Intern (实习生)

**Start Date:** Flexible

**Internship Agreement Term:** Typically 6 months

**Entity:** Beijing Mutianyu Schoolhouse Restaurant Company, Ltd. (MSR)

**Work Location:** Mutianyu Village, Beijing, China

**Work Schedule:** Typically 5-6 days including weekends, holidays, and some evenings.

**Trial Period:** Not Applicable

**Gross Stipend:** Rmb 1,500 per month. Intern responsible for own taxes (if any).

**Lodging:** Intern will be provided a shared room in staff dormitory in Mutianyu. Intern may use a room in company apartment in downtown Beijing on days off.

**Meals:** Intern will be provided two meals daily each work day (Lunch & Dinner) with staff and also with the option to order a la carte one meal daily (appetizer, main, beverage).

**Local Transportation:** Intern will be provided with round-trip transportation to and from Beijing on days off.

**Communications:** Interns must use a cell phone and MSR will reimburse up to Rmb 100 per month in calling expenses. Interns are encouraged to bring laptop computers; all MSR facilities have free wireless internet.

**Visa and Invitation:** Intern responsible for obtaining own visa for the People's Republic of China. MSR will issue an official invitation to be used to apply for the visa.

**Medical Insurance:** Intern responsible for own medical insurance and must provide proof of coverage prior to beginning internship.

**Airfare:** Intern responsible for own international airfare to/from China.
